




What's next?

- Each decade seems to be defined by a key investment theme
 - Probably won't be another driven defined by American stocks in 2024-2030.
 - U.S. equity markets, at 43% of the global share, vs its economic output, of 26% of the world's total so leading a price, growth or valued change unlikely.
 - Stark differences in valuations. U.S. stock market is at its highest compared to the rest of the world in 100 years - so probably overvalued and set for a (relative) fall.
 - Could global (ex. USA) stocks become the leaders in global equity market share? Anyone's guess ???


